BackPack Buddies FAQs

1. How do I sign up to volunteer?

- Contact Kyle at kyle@foodshuttle.org or call him at 250-0043 to request dates and times of available opportunities. This should be done at least a month in advance as slots fill up very quickly.

2. When are volunteer opportunities available?

- Most Monday, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays have morning sessions (10am-12pm) and afternoon sessions (1pm-3pm) available. Once a month there will be a Saturday opportunity available (10am-12pm). You may choose to volunteer for only one hour. Contact Kyle for availability of these time slots.

3. What will I be doing when I volunteer with the BackPack Buddies Program?

- The two main things people do when they volunteer with BackPack Buddies are packing the backpacks full of nutritious food to be delivered to children and sorting food from food drives collected by the Food Shuttle for BackPack Buddies. However, other odd jobs can come up that volunteers may need to help with. Some examples of odd jobs can be organizing shelves, counting backpacks, checking expiration dates on food items, or putting together orders for deliveries.

4. Are there any special rules/requirements to working with BackPack Buddies?

- Yes! We will be working in the warehouse, which means everyone must wear closed-toe shoes and have their shoulders covered.
- There is no specific age requirement, however anybody age 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

5. Where are you located?

- Our Raleigh office is located at 1001 Blair Dr. Raleigh, NC 27603. It is near the State Farmer's Market and Dorothea Dix Campus.
